 - Fed's Power to Buoy Corporate Debt Market Curbed by Bailout Law: -When Congress gave the Federal Reserve \$750 billion of emergency firepower to backstop the country's biggest companies, some lawmakers insisted on inserting a clause that now threatens to undermine the program -and could pose a major problem if markets go haywire again. Under the stimulus bill passed last month to combat the coronavirus crisis, the central bank is wading into corporate credit markets for the first time since the 1950s. One Fed facility will lend directly to companies and another will buy bonds in the secondary market. Yet the legislation also imposed a key condition: Only a borrower with "significant operations in and a majority of its employees based in the United States" is eligible for Fed support.
 - Dollar Pushes Higher; Rosebank in Play: - The U.S. dollar has risen in early European trade, as more turmoil in the oil markets resulted in traders taking a less expansive stance with risk, heading back to the safe haven.

The act or practice of buying stocks only to resell them at a profit very quickly. Stock jobbing is a short-term investment strategy that operates on the assumption or existence of liquid markets.

Arbitrage

Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example
As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
